



ARARAT KIDS SUMMER CAMP TERMS & CONDITIONS 2025

REGISTRATION

To register your child or children for the Ararat Kids Summer Camp, you will need to complete an online registration form. The online registration application has an option to complete one application for siblings from the same family. Please select second child registration and third child registration when completing the application for siblings attending camp. Forms are processed in the order they are received, along with the appropriate payment. Please ensure that all required fields are completed before submitting the form. Incomplete forms may cause a delay in the registration process.

All payments must be submitted through the online payment portal. Please note that weekly capacity is limited to 60 children. Once this limit is reached, applications will be closed, and a waitlist will be initiated for the respective week.

To secure your child's place in the camp, full payment for the week is required by the Friday of the previous week. If you fail to meet this deadline, a late fee of \$30 will be applied (if space permits). Additionally, if registration occurs for the first time on Monday morning, a \$30 late fee will be applied with no exceptions.

Please note that Homenetmen Glendale Ararat reserves the right to refuse service or entry to any child whose behavior may disrupt the curriculum of the Ararat Kids Summer Camp.

PRICES & DISCOUNTS

The camp fee is \$425.00 per week if registered by June 6, 2025. After June 6, 2025 the camp fee will be \$450.00 per week. Week 2 will be a short week due to 4th of July holiday. The fee for week 2 will be \$255.00 if registered by June 6, 2025 and \$270.00 if registered after June 6th. There will be a \$25.00 per week discount for children who attend all 7 weeks. The fee includes breakfast, lunch, and care from 8:00 am - 4:00 pm. Siblings attending at the same time will receive 10% off the second and third child's weekly fee.

HOURS OF OPERATION

Summer Camp program hours are 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. The center is open from 8:00 a.m. for early drop off until 4:00 p.m. for late pick up.

DROP OFF AND PICK UP

Please drop off and pick up your child at the back entrance. Drop off is between 8:00 am and 9:00 am and pick up is between 3:00 pm and 4:00 pm. We kindly request that you park your car and walk your child into the center. You must sign your child in and out during drop off and pick up.

If you are late for pick up, there will be a late pick up fee of \$1 per minute that must be paid upon picking up your child. Children will be waiting in the gated area at the back entrance. If you need to pick up your child at an earlier time, please coordinate with Melineh Ebrahimian, the camp director, at (818) 486-3115.

WHAT TO SEND WITH YOUR CHILD TO CAMP

Each child must have a backpack with a water bottle, extra clothes, and afternoon snack. Ararat Kids Camp will provide all other necessary materials for daily activities.

LOST AND FOUND

Please make sure to label all your child's belongings, including their water bottle, extra clothes, and any other items that are sent to camp in their backpack. Children will be responsible for their personal belongings. In case something gets lost, Ararat Kids Camp will have a lost and found area available for parents to look through. Any items left at the camp will be donated after the last week of the camp.

ABSENCES

All children must be registered for the full week of camp. If your child is unable to attend a day of camp for any reason, please inform the camp director as soon as possible. Please note that missed days cannot be made up and credits will not be given for any reason.

Refunds will only be given if your child is absent from camp due to a medical issue that requires a note from their physician. Each refund request will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. If approved, the refund request will be processed by our accounting office. Please note that a \$50 processing fee per child will be deducted from the refund amount.

Refunds will be made after the conclusion of camp.

ACCIDENTS

If a child gets injured while at Ararat Kids Camp and requires emergency medical attention, the staff will make every effort to get in touch with their parents, guardians, or emergency contacts. In case the medical treatment is not covered by the child's health or accident insurance, Ararat's accident insurance will provide coverage up to the policy limits for any injuries that the child sustains while at the camp.

IMPORTANT NOTES

Electronic devices such as video games, cell phones, iPods, iPads, tablets, smart watches, etc. are **NOT** allowed to be used between 9:00 am and 3:00 pm. Children can always make calls from our office phone if they need to speak to their parents. Electronic devices that are used between 9:00 am and 3:00 pm will be confiscated for the day and returned to the parent at the time of pick up.
